InterAge Adult Day Program is a full service, medical model program serving Rutland County adults 18 and older who may have dementia or other cognitive impairment, medical issues or physical challenges and elders who may be socially isolated.

By promoting socialization, optimum health, fitness and creativity, we meet our primary goal of preventing or postponing institutional care for this population.

To be eligible for enrollment there must be an indication of one or more of the following:

- Family/Caregiver is in need of respite from 24 hour care of the individual
- The individual requires supervision in a structured situation while family/caregiver works
- The individual requires functional and/or medical monitoring
- The individual requires socialization/stimulation of the day program to avoid isolation

Let our qualified and caring staff provide a friendly, safe and stimulating place for your loved one or the person in your care.



Respite

Families/Caregivers benefit from a much needed break from the daily stress of care giving. They can more easily balance remaining in the workplace and juggling family or other responsibilities.
